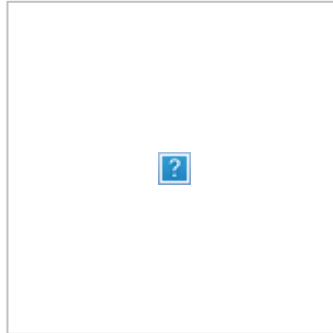
In 2021, South Africa experienced the hard reality of long-standing risks materialising with devastating impacts, such as the July 2021 unrest.

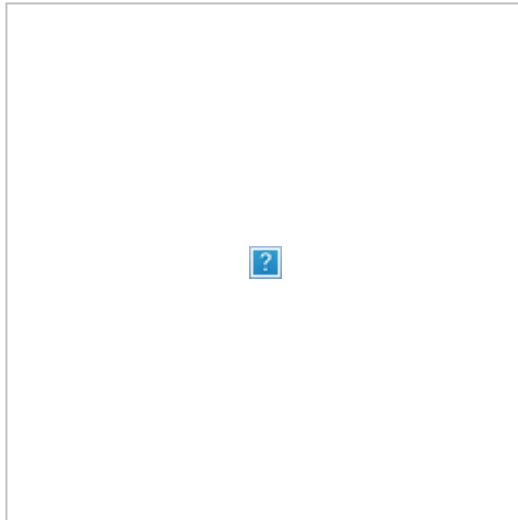
