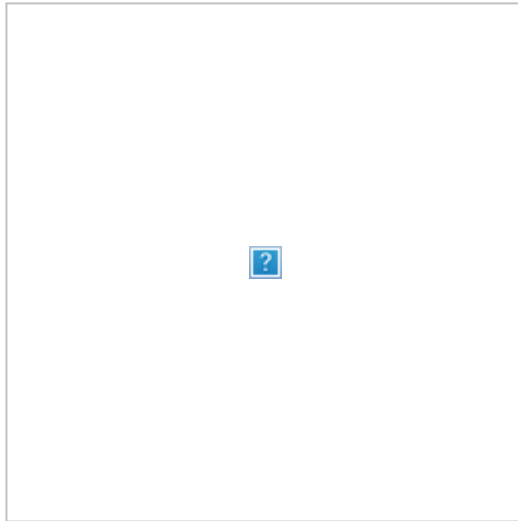

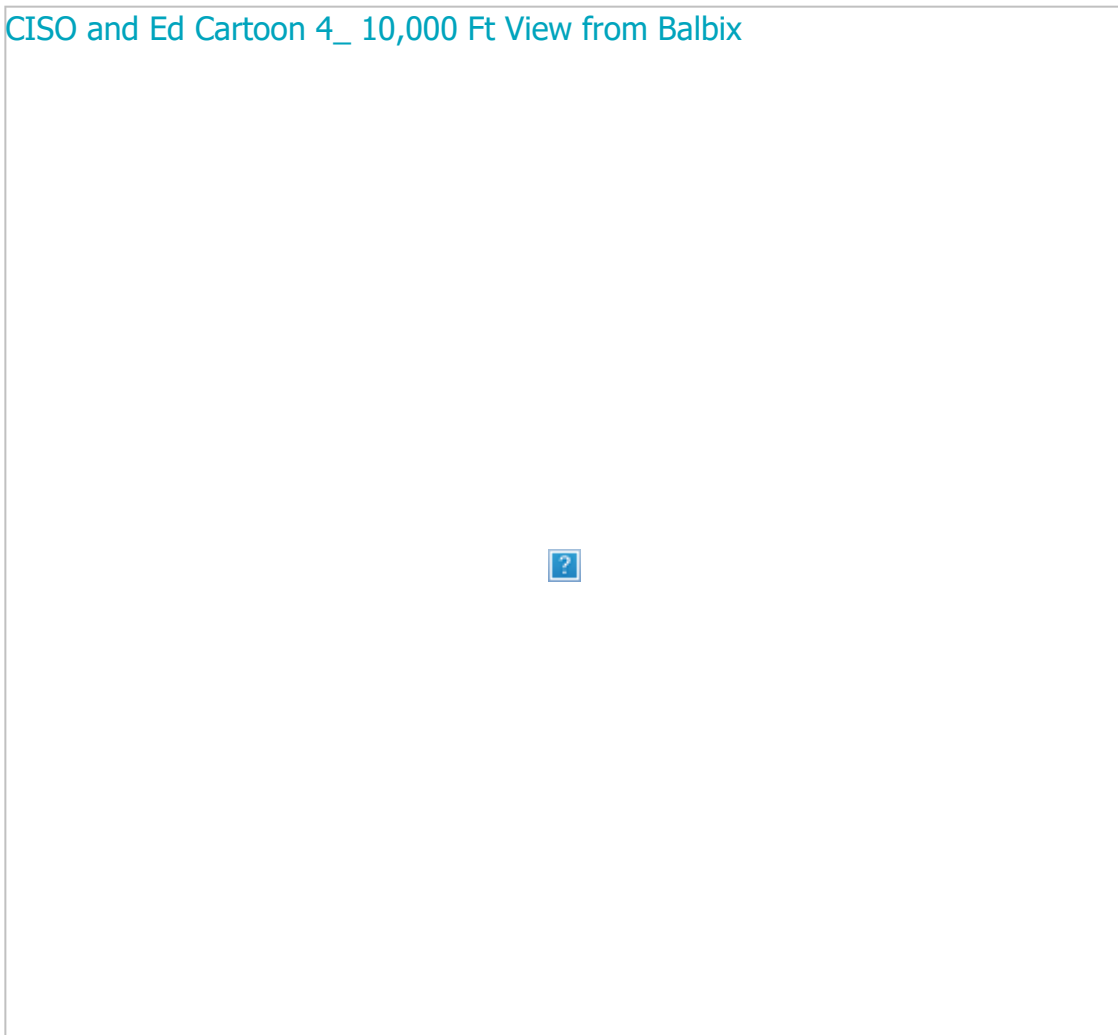

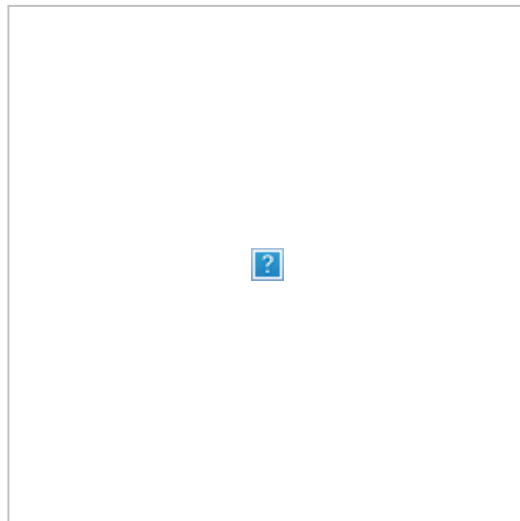

### **Advancing internet *freedom* in Africa through the Universal Periodic Review (UPR): Lessons and Gaps**

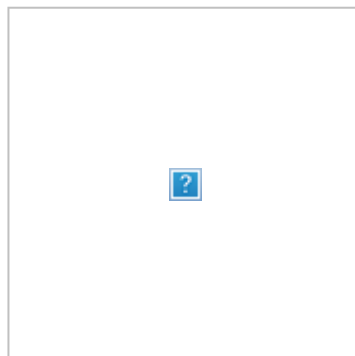
